





"THE 2016 INDUCTEES"

In the Builder Category, **PAT QUINN** (posthumous) was elected. After nine seasons in the NHL, Pat joined the Philadelphia Flyers as an assistant coach in 1977. Over the next almost 40 years, he held coaching, managing and President positions, both in the NHL and with Team Canada. At the time of his death in November, 2014, he was Chair of the Hockey Hall of Fame.

"Being recognized by Pat's hockey peers is truly a great honour," said his wife, Sandra Quinn. "I'm proud of Pat and what he accomplished."

ERIC LINDROS exemplified the power forward position throughout his 14 year NHL career. He won gold for Canada both at the Olympic Games and the Canada Cup and also averaged over a point a game in the NHL.

"I was very fortunate to have coaches, teammates, billets and parents who supported me throughout my career." said Lindros. "It also takes a lot of luck to get to the NHL."

SERGEI MAKAROV led the Soviet League in scoring for nine seasons, while also winning eight World Championship gold medals and two Olympic gold medals. He later joined the NHL as a member of the Calgary Flames in 1989 and went on to play in over 400 NHL games.

"For everyone who plays the game, this is the top place," said Markarov. "It will be so nice to join all of those great players."

ROGIE VACHON joined the Montreal Canadiens in 1966 and won three Stanley Cups in his first six NHL seasons. After being traded to the LA Kings in 1971, he continued his stellar career for 11 more seasons before retiring to become an NHL coach and executive.

"I was very lucky to play for the Montreal Canadiens at the start of my career," said Vachon. "My first shot on net was a breakaway by Gordie Howe. I stopped it and it kept me in the league for 16 more years."



Team Captain, #88, HOF Eric Lindros, Forward, born Feb 28, 1973, London, ON

Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2016

Played in the NHL from 1992-2007 with Philadelphia Flyers (8 years), NY Rangers, Toronto Maple Leafs and Dallas Stars Won NHL All-Rookie (1992), Hart Memorial Trophy (1995), Lester B. Pearson Trophy (1995), NHL First All-Star (1996), Bobby Clarke Trophy - 4 times, NHL All-Star -7 times

1 Olympic Gold Medal (2002) and 1 Olympic Silver Medal (1992) when he played for Team Canada

#20, HOF Dino Ciccarelli, Forward, born Feb 8, 1960, Sarnia, ON

Played in the NHL for 19 seasons from 1980-1999 with primarily Minnesota North Stars, then the Detroit Red Wings, Tampa Bay and Florida Panthers Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2010

1230 career points, 608 goals

#77, HOF Paul Coffey, Defense, born June 1, 1961, Weston, ON

Played in NHL from 1980-2001 with Edmonton, Pittsburgh, Los Angeles, Detroit, Hartford, Philadelphia, Chicago, Caroline and Boston Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2004 Won 4 Stanley Cups with Edmonton (3) and Pittsburgh (1) Was on the Legendary Edmonton Oilers dynasty team with Wayne Gretzky, Mark Messier, Jari Kurri and Glenn Anderson NHL Defensemen - All-Time Points Leader recording 346 goals, 1531 points and 1035 assists Won the James Norris Memorial Trophy (3) and Canada Cup (3)

#10, HOF Dale Hawerchuk, Forward, born April 4, 1963, Toronto, ON

Played for 16 seasons in the NHL from 1981-1997 with the Winnipeg, Buffalo and Philadelphia Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2001 Captain for the Winnipeg Jets where he played for 9 years In 1188 NHL games he scored 518 goals and 891 assists Has won numerous NHL Awards Also Inducted into the Buffalo Sabres Hall of Fame and the Manitoba Sports Hall of Fame

#8, HOF Igor Larionov, nicknamed "The Professor", Defense, born Dec 3, 1960, Voskresensk, Russia Played in the NHL from 1989-2003 with Vancouver, San Jose, Detroit, Florida and New Jersey Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2008 Won 3 Stanley Cups with the Detroit Red Wings (1997, 1998, 2002) For Russia (USSR): Winter Olympics - won 2 Golds (1984, 1988) & 1 Bronze – World Cups - won 4 Golds, 1 Silver and 1 Bronze Was instrumental (1997-1998) in breaking the barrier that kept the Soviet players from joining the NHL

#55, HOF Larry Murphy, Defense, born March 8, 1961, Scarborough, ON Played in the NHL from 1980 till 2001 with Los Angeles, Washington, Minnesota, Pittsburgh, Toronto, and Detroit Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2004 Won 2 Stanley Cup Championships with the Pittsburgh Penguins, where he played for 4 years, and won 2 Stanley Cups with the Detroit Red Wings, where he played for 5 years Was a 1st round draft choice with the LA Kings in 1980 Selected to the NHL All-Star team numerous times

Honorary Coach, Sergei Makarov, Forward, born June 19, 1958, Chelyabinsk, USSR

Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2016 Starred on the famed Soviet KLM Line (with Valdimir Krutov and Igor Larionov) Won 10 World Championships with the CKSA Moscow Team from 1978-1990 Won 2 Olympic Golds (1984 & 1988) as a member of the USSR Team In the 1980 Olympics, at the famed "Miracle On Ice" game against the USA, Sergei scored the 2nd of 3 goals for Russia to win the Bronze Was one of the first Soviet stars to play in the NHL when he signed with Calgary Flames in 1989 Played in the NHL from 1989 - 1997 with Calgary, San Jose and Dallas

Team Captain, **#21, HOF Börje Salming,** nicknamed "*The King*", Defense, born April 17, 1951, Kiruna, Sweden Played 17 years in the NHL from 1973-1990 Toronto Maple Leafs (16 years) and Detroit Red Wings (1 year) Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1990 Holds numerous franchise records with the Toronto Maple Leafs (including most assists) Is still one of the most cherished Leafs players of all time He was one of the first Europeans to make an impact in the NHL, paving the way for generations of players

#27 HOF Darryl Sittler, Forward, born Sept 15, 1951, Kitchener-Waterloo, ON Played 15 years in the NHL from 1979-1985 Toronto Maple Leafs (12 years), Philadelphia & Detroit Captain – Toronto Maple Leafs 1975-79 & 1980-82 Played 1148 regular season games

Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 1989 On Feb 7, 1976 he set an NHL record that still stands today for points scored in one game, recording 10 points (6 goals & 4 assists) against the Boston Bruins Inducted into the Canadian Walk of Fame in 2016

#93 HOF Doug Gilmour, nicknamed "*Killer"*, Forward, born June 25, 1963, Kingston, ON Played 20 years in the NHL from 1983 to 2003 with St. Louis, Calgary, Toronto, New Jersey, Chicago, Boston, and Montreal Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2011 Captain – Toronto Maple Leafs in 1994 Most popular player in the Leafs franchise during his 6 years with the Team (1991-1997) Won 1 Stanley Cup with the Calgary Flames in 1989, the Frank J. Selke Trophy and Canada Cup in 1987. Recorded 1414 points in 474 games

#11 HOF Mike Gartner, Forward, born Oct 29, 1959, Ottawa, ON Played 19 years in the NHL with Washington, Minnesota, NY Rangers, Toronto Maple Leafs and Phoenix Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2001 Played for the Toronto Maple Leafs from 1993-96 Scored 708 career goals

#17 Wendel Clark, Forward, born Oct 25, 1966, Kelvington, SK

Played in the NHL from 1985-2000 with Toronto, Quebec, NY Islanders, Tampa Bay, Detroit, and Chicago Was chosen 1st overall in the 1985 NHL Entry Draft by the Toronto Maple Leafs (the team he played on 3 separate occasions for 13 years) Career – 888 games, 367 goals, 266 assists Former captain of the Maple Leafs, one of the most sought after retired players in the Toronto area

#22 Rick Vaive, Forward, born May 14, 1959, Ottawa, ON Played 15 years in the NHL from 1979 to 1992 with Vancouver, Toronto, Chicago and Buffalo Played 8 years with the Toronto Maple Leafs from 1979-87 Captain – Toronto Maple Leafs from 1982-86 First 50-goal scorer in Toronto Maple Leafs franchise history

Honorary Coach, Rogie Vachon, born Sept 8, 1945, Palmarolle, QC

Inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2016 Played in Goal in the NHL from 1965-1987 with Montreal, LA Kings, Detroit Won 3 Stanley Cup Championships with the Montreal Canadiens in 1968, 1969 and 1971 Winner of the Vezina Trophy in 1968 First Red Wing to break \$1 million/year Vachon served as general manager of the Kings from 1984 to 1992 He also served as interim head coach of the Kings on three separate occasions
